

Retail Therapy St Malo



St Malo offers visitors excellent retail therapy, with a wide choice of hypermarkets and specialist shopping plus the usual tourist boutiques and souvenir shops.

Amble along the ancient cobbled streets, enjoy the shops full of local crafts, browse the open markets or try some of the great seafood restaurants, bars and boutiques. St Malo offers a host of delicious recipes, from the traditional meal of crepes and cider to prestigious gourmet feasts.



In the old town, tantalizing aromas drift from a wide variety of restaurants and cafes. Craft shops will tempt you with an array of finely made merchandise. You may even encounter a group of wandering street entertainers eager to show off their skills.

For those bringing their car to St Malo, the city also offers large hypermarkets carrying a range of lower priced goods including clothes, electrical goods and food. For Channel Islanders a large Carrefour is found just outside the port of St. Malo and is well sign-posted from the port. Carrefour opens late up until 8.30 but closes on Sunday.

Visit the daily markets within the town and sample some typical French delicacies from the traditional outdoor markets (from 8am to 1pm). The markets traditionally sell an array of local produce, superb fresh seafood and local delicacies such as fine cheese, potent home-made cider and warm sweet galettes to tempt the appetite.

Looking for something a bit different? Why not visit the popular shopping streets such as rue du Broussais and rue St-Vincent. They are full of outlets selling mariners' jumpers, stripy Breton T-shirts and sou'westers.

For a chic option pop into Vent de Voyages in rue St-Thomas where they recycle sails into stylish hand-made bags and cushions. Top Fromager Jean-Yves Bordier (rue de l'Orme) is a superb shop with an array of local cheeses to sample. Behind the cathedral, the stalls of Maison Guella sell salty caramels and chocolate sardines for that alternative souvenir option.
