A Taste of Jersey's Best!

Royal Bay Oysters (Jersey) is a registered business name of La Rocque Fisheries Limited and uses HD Ferries new Freight service.

Royal Bay Oysters cultivate Pacific Oysters (*Crassostrea Gigas*) on 24 hectares of intertidal beds in the Royal Bay of Grouville - Jersey.

Seed Oysters (spat) are purchased from government approved hatcheries in France and the UK - therefore maintaining purity and avoiding the importation of alien species and diseases. All cultivation is carried out in purpose designed plastic mesh bags attached to steel tressle tables. Spat purchased in March at 6mm length will attain an average market size of 85 grams in 18 to 24 months.

Royal Bay Oysters are now entering a period of expansion which will see a three-fold increase in production. The principal market is France with a rapidly increasing UK market and further afield requirement for the delicious product.

Jersey has the added benefit of having obtained 'approved zone' status (freedom from notifiable oyster diseases) which not only allows oysters to be sold overseas for relaying and on-growing but also controls the import of harmful and diseased shellfish into Jersey waters.
