## Thursday 27th – Sunday 30th March - World 2008 Kenpo Karate Championships

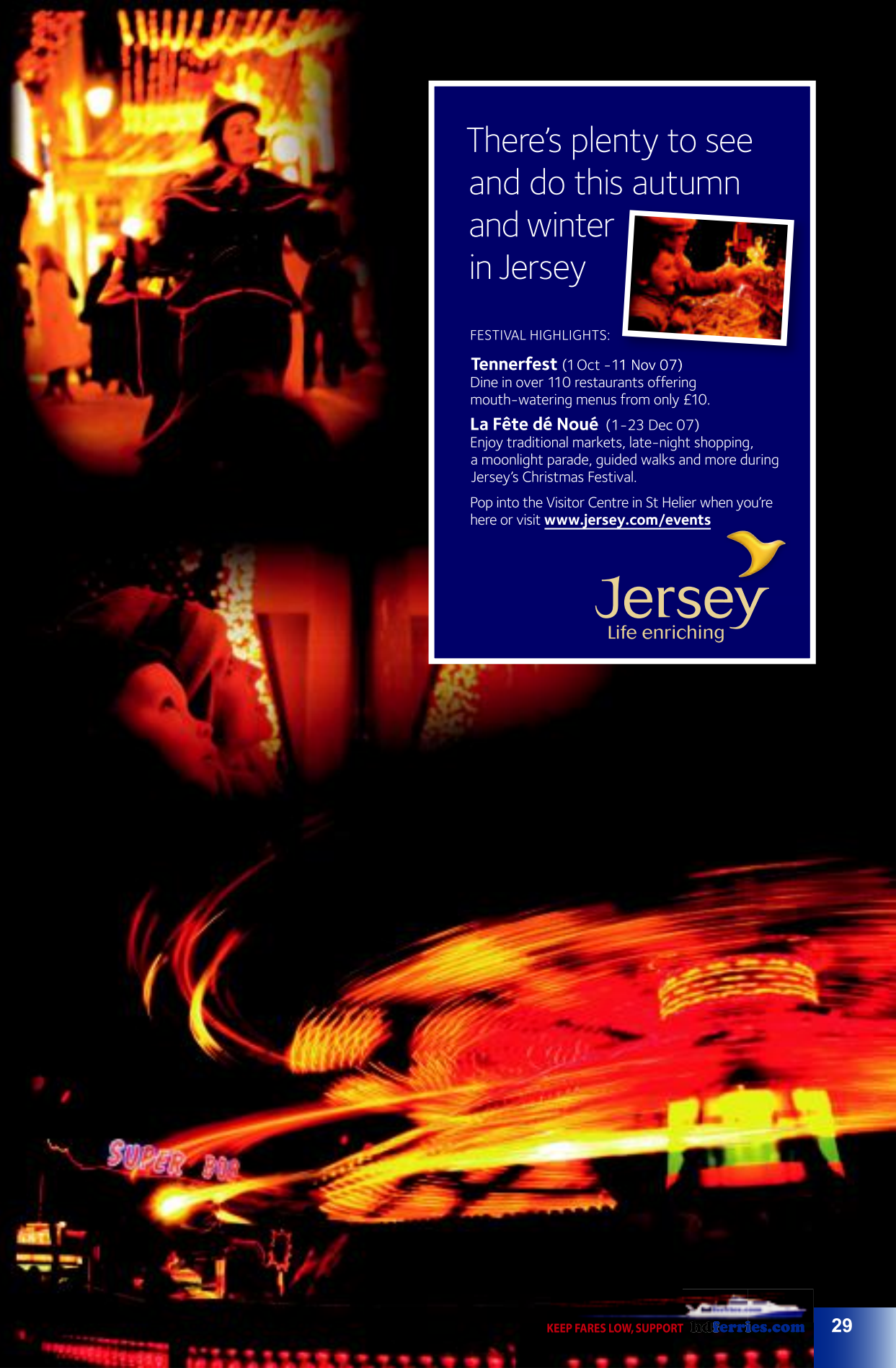
Over 1000 karate experts and competitors from around the world gather to compete in the World Championships.
